2nd-Lieut. Robert Thompson was the eldest son of Mr Arthur Thompson, of Castle Street, Warkworth. He was educated at the Dukes School, Alnwick and in January, 1916, joined the K.R.R.'S "Yeomanry Battalion" under Lord Feversham. He went to the front I May, 1916, and after promotion in the ranks was given a commission in the field, being gazetted to the Northumberland Fusiliers. He saw much fighting and was awarded the Military Cross in July, for his ability and daring. He was killed in action on the 26 October, 1917, in the 21st year of his age. The sympathy of all ranks goes out to his father.
